

① OVERALL IMPRESSIONS

EDGWORTH IS LET DOWN BY A LARGE AMOUNT OF WEED, ALTHOUGH THERE IS NO GRAFFITI OR LITTER, ROAD SIDE PLANTING IN TUBS IS EVIDENCE OF A SENSE OF PRIDE, THERE ARE AREAS (SUCH AS THE CENTRAL AREA INCORPORATING THE VILLAGE HALL) WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT - PARTS GOOD OTHERS NOT SO.

② OUTSTANDING FEATURES

MOST HOUSES ARE IN A GOOD STATE OF REPAIR. A GOOD EXAMPLE IS THE MOOREN ESTATE (CROWNDALE WITH ITS WATER LILY POND, AND GREEN THORN CLOSE). THE PRIMARY SCHOOL IS VERY GOOD, THE COMMERCIAL AREA WITH ITS SHOPS AND CROSS-ROADS IS A PLEASANT FEATURE OF THE VILLAGE. THE SHOP (HOLDEN AND CO) IS EYE-CATCHING

③ AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

WHILST BARLOW COURT IS WELL-MAINTAINED, THERE IS AN APPARENT LACK OF WEED KILLING ON THE FORECOURT. THE CHILDREN'S PLAY AREA IS OVERGROWN AND GIVING A SENSE OF NEGLECT. THE METHODIST CHURCH GROUNDS ARE SIMILARLY NEGLECTED
